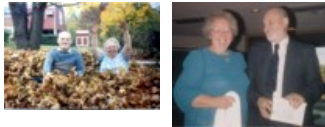

Julian Deichman Rose, age 91, of Spring Arbor, Michigan, passed away Tuesday, May 9, 2017, at Arbor Manor. He was born during the Dust Bowl on July 18, 1925, in Winfield, Kansas, the first child of Reverend Julian Donovan and Berneice Lorena (Deichman) Rose. His family moved to Chicago in 1935. He graduated from Tilden Technical High School in Chicago in 1943. At age 18, he became a hospital corpsman in the U.S. Navy in service to his country during World War II. He served in the South Pacific on Tinian Island witnessing the return of the Enola Gay with its lights on signaling "Mission Accomplished". He graduated from...
