Russell E. Kinnaman, 87, formerly of New Castle, went home to be with the Lord on the afternoon of Sunday, September 24, 2017 at The Hearth at Stones Crossing in Greenwood.

He was born March 20, 1930, in Pleasant Plains, Illinois, a son of the late Albert G. and Bernice (Brown) Kinnaman.

Russ was a 1949 graduate of Knightstown High School. He married Joyce R. (Baker) Kinnaman on September 5, 1953 and together they enjoyed 56 years of marriage. Russ attended Purdue University and Wayne State University. He worked for Chrysler Corporation for 37 years mostly in executive personnel management in Indiana, Michigan and Geneva, Switzerland. He served in the US Army from 1951- 1953 in Europe during the Korean Conflict. Russ loved working with people, mentoring, personal evangelism and working with youth groups. He served on various church boards, The New Castle-Henry County Chamber of Commerce and was the chairman of a church building program. He taught Adult Sunday School class and served as Sunday School Superintendent. Russ also served on the advisory board for the Free Methodist Conference. He enjoyed spending summers in Michigan and winters in Florida.

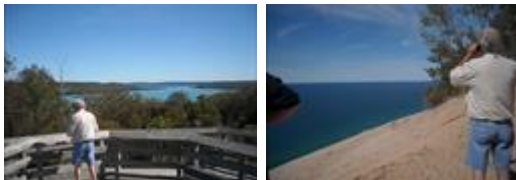

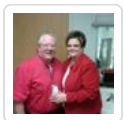
